### **Author Interview (optional)**

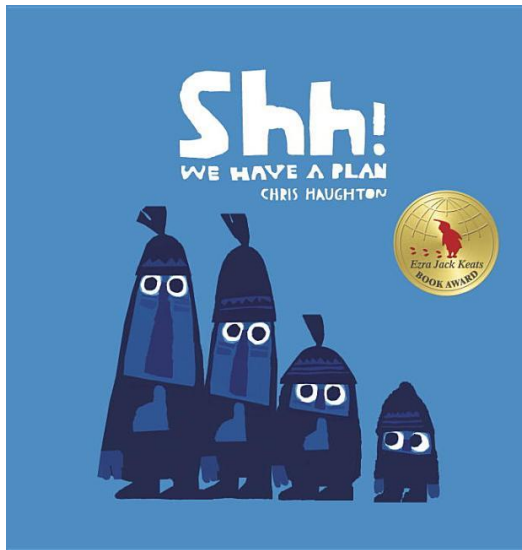
**Overview:** Learn something new about the author
