Estimated Time: 10 - 15

Explanation of Activity/Assignment: Use the online resource Britannica School to learn more about Walt Disney. When you go to the home page of Britannica School simply type in Walt Disney. After your search results come up and the word Walt Disney is at the top, click on the word Walt Disney (highlighted in blue). You can go back and forth between article reading level tabs 1 and 2. (it all depends on your own reading level). Enjoy reading!
