### Week of March 29

**Overview:** Foster a love of reading and hearing stories read aloud.

**Estimated Time:** 5 – 10 minutes daily

**Explanation of Activity/Assignment:** Use the link below to access the YouTube video of the author/illustrator of the book **I'm Bored**. Listen to Michael Ian Black read aloud the book. Then pause it to talk to someone about what you liked in the book. Then start the video where Debbie is teaching you to illustrate emotions. Give it a try.

**Bonus:** What are some things you would do to prove to Potato that kids aren't boring?

**Things to know:** After hearing the story talk to mom/dad/sibling/stuffed animal about your favorite part or character and why. Discuss story elements like character, setting, problem, and solution. Try drawing alongside Debbie.

**Tasks:** • Hear the story read aloud. • Talk about favorite parts of the story. • Identify main character(s), setting, problem, solution. • Draw with the illustrator.
